Code of Conduct & Ethics

Our league is founded on principles of respect, sportsmanship, and unity within the Muslim community. To ensure a positive and enjoyable experience for all participants, we have established this Code of Conduct. All players, and spectators are expected to adhere to these guidelines:

- 1) **Respect for All:** Treat all players, volunteers, leadership, and spectators with respect, regardless of their background or skill level. Discrimination and harassment will not be tolerated.
- 2) **Sportsmanship:** Display good sportsmanship by respecting opponents, and teammates.
- 3) **Fair Play:** Play by the rules and accept the results without argument. Refrain from cheating or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- 4) **Teamwork:** Embrace teamwork and cooperation. Encourage and support your teammates and communicate positively both on and off the court.
- 5) **Conflict Resolution:** Address conflicts calmly and respectfully. Seek mediation from leadership if necessary to resolve disputes.
- 6) **Language and Behavior:** Avoid offensive language, gestures, or actions. Maintain self-control, and refrain from behavior that incites violence or disrupts the game.
- 7) **Attire:** Adhere to appropriate attire guidelines outlined by the league, including modest clothing that covers the awrah (private parts) and torso.
- 8) **Safety:** Prioritize safety on and off the court. Report any unsafe conditions or actions to league officials promptly.
- 9) **Drug and Alcohol Policy:** The use of alcohol, drugs, marijuana, smoking of any kind or any prohibited substances is strictly prohibited on the premise.
- 10) **Pray Time:** Accommodate players who need to perform their religious obligations, such as prayer. The league will work to schedule games in a way that respects these obligations.
- 11) **Other Business:** No solicitations of any kind whatsoever anywhere on the premises.
