



Parents' Consent and Agreement

Quran School — Masjid Bilal, Islamic Society of Cumberland

About the Program

The Masjid Bilal Quran School is a community program established and operated by community members to provide Islamic and Quranic education to Muslim children in the Orleans area. This agreement sets out the mutual expectations between the school and the parents/guardians of enrolled students. By signing below, you confirm that you have read, understood, and agreed to the terms of this document.

Curriculum and Learning Goals

The school offers Quranic education covering recitation, Tajweed (correct pronunciation), memorization, and foundational understanding of the Quran. Supplementary sessions on Islamic conduct, etiquette, and character development are provided periodically.

Attendance and Punctuality

Regular and punctual attendance is essential to your child's progress and to the integrity of the learning environment. Parents are responsible for:

- Ensuring their child attends all scheduled classes on time
- Notifying the school in advance of any absence
- Avoiding late drop-offs, which disrupt active learning sessions

Class updates, schedule changes, and cancellations are communicated by email and WhatsApp to registered parents only. It is the parent's responsibility to stay informed.

Registration, Payments, and Contributions

The school operates on a cost-recovery and donation basis. By registering:

- Payments are made online as part of the registration process
- Enrollment is on a first-come, first-served basis, to a maximum registration based on teacher capacity
- Continued enrollment is conditional on regular attendance and participation

Code of Conduct — Students

Students are expected to:

- Follow instructions from teachers and staff at all times
- Treat teachers, staff, and fellow students with respect
- Maintain behaviour appropriate for a masjid environment

Disruptive or disrespectful behaviour will result in the student being removed from the class and parents being notified immediately. Repeated issues may result in suspension or termination of enrollment.

Code of Conduct — Parents and Guardians

Parents play a critical role in the success of this program. Parents are expected to:

- Reinforce school teachings at home — listening to recitation, supporting memorization, and encouraging consistent practice

- Ensure their child arrives with wudhu (ablution) and all required materials (Quran, notebook, etc.). No spare materials are provided; lost books are replaced at cost
- Dress their child modestly and appropriately for a masjid setting (no shorts, no clothing with inappropriate imagery or slogans)
- Drop off and pick up their child within the masjid building
- Direct all concerns or feedback to the masjid administration — not directly to teachers or volunteers
- Keep contact information up to date with the school at all times

Homework and Home Practice

Parents must ensure their child completes all assigned homework and memorization on time. Active involvement at home — such as listening to recitation and offering encouragement — is strongly encouraged and directly impacts the child's progress.

Health and Safety

Parents must disclose any health conditions, allergies, or behavioural concerns prior to enrollment. This information is confidential and used solely to support your child's wellbeing. Please note that school staff are not authorized or equipped to administer any medication. In the event of an emergency, the school will contact the parent or guardian using the information on file.

Commitment to the Program

Enrollment in this school is a commitment — not just a registration. The school invests significant volunteer time and resources into each child. In turn, we ask that parents treat this program with the same seriousness as any academic commitment: regular attendance, timely payments, active support at home, and respectful conduct from both children and parents are all required for continued enrollment.

Termination of Agreement

Either party may terminate this agreement with written notice if the terms above are not being met. The school reserves the right to withdraw enrollment in cases of persistent non-attendance, non-payment, or conduct that is harmful to the learning environment.
